


# RECLAIMED WATER

## PURPLE IS THE NEW GREEN

In partnership with the City of Boerne, The Lookout Group has constructed Boerne's first reclaimed water tank rising over 150 feet above the community. Towering high over the tree line and Highway 46, the green tank is a symbol of Esperanza's commitment to sustainability and environmental stewardship.

Residents can buy reclaimed water at a cheaper rate than potable water.

### How it Works

Potable waste water gets collected, treated, and used for irrigation within Esperanza.



**820,000 GALLONS**  
of water stored inside Esperanza's water tank

**20 MILES**  
of planned reclaimed main line through the community

**\$25 MILLION INVESTMENT**  
by the developer for reclaimed tanks and water lines.

**240 MILLION GALLONS**  
of potable water saved per year.  
Equivalent to  
**364 OLYMPIC-SIZED**  
swimming pools.

**16,700 FEET**  
of purple pipe laid in Phase 1
